RECONCILIATION PROJECT



The Global Peace Foundation is partnering with The United Way of Central Maryland to convene the next phase of a unique pilot project in Baltimore designed to reduce racial bias and discrimination, increase understanding and empathy, and strengthen connections among our city's diverse community members.

Participants of the Baltimore Cross-Community Reconciliation Project will:

- Engage in educational and awareness-raising gatherings with other change agents and leaders from the Baltimore community, including residents, educators, law enforcement, not-for-profit and business organizations, and faith and community leaders;
- Commit to 10 bi-weekly evening gatherings, with a start date of April 3, 2024. Sessions will take place at the University of Baltimore Learning Commons, 1415 Maryland Avenue, Baltimore, MD.
- Work to better comprehend racial conflict dynamics (histories, grievances, incidences, policies, etc.) and provide a platform for reconciliation and change;

Enjoy opportunities to continue peace building and strengthen connections among diverse community members.
